

MINUTES OF THE ALBERT TOWNSHIP BOARD

MEETING HELD JUNE 1, 2020

Supervisor Mike Dombrowski called the Albert Township Board Meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. with all Board Members in attendance. There were 3 residence, Zoning Administrator, and Maintenance Supervisor in attendance.

Trustee Roger Cohoe led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Trustee Roger Cohoe made a **motion** to approve the Minutes of May 18, 2020 seconded by Trustee Dick Deska. Motion carried with 5 yea votes.

Trustee Roger Cohoe made a **motion** to pay the List of Bills in the amount of \$9,168.95, and Payroll in the amount of \$19,818.15, seconded by Trustee Dick Deska. Motion carried with 5 yea votes.

Ed Paton Maintenance Supervisor informed the Board that during the Virus shut down the Township had 8 burials. The bathroom at the Township garage was framed in, plumbing installed, and he is in the process of finishing the mudding of the wall board. The Board discussed putting the Buoys in, and decided to get them installed as soon as possible. A porta potty will be installed at the beach during the temporary closure of the Beach House while work is being completed.

Deb Downing Zoning Administrator presented the Zoning Report which was received and file by the Board. Discussion was held on a couple of violations within the Township with Trustee Cohoe stating that it was time to play hard ball with some of the violators who just keep ignoring request to fix the violations.

The Board discuss the directions for opening the office during the COVID 19 outbreak, directed by the Governor of Michigan. The office will open June 2, 2020 with all employees attending a meeting to discuss the directions for running the Township's working procedures for office workers and maintenance department. The Transfer Site will go back to regular summer hours starting Wednesday.

Brining was discussed with the Supervisor stating that he was hoping for a date towards the middle of June so roads would be brined for Fourth of July holiday.
