

MINUTES OF THE ALBERT TOWNSHIP
BOARD MEETING HELD NOVEMBER 1, 2021

Supervisor Mike Runyan called the Albert Township Board Meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with all Board Members in attendance. There were 3 residents in the audience.

Supervisor Runyan led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Trustee Roger Cohoe made a **motion** to approve the Minutes of October 18, 2021 as presented, seconded by Trustee Dick Deska. Motion carried with 5 yea votes.

Trustee Cohoe made a **motion** to approve the Minutes of October 26, 2021 as presented, seconded by Trustee Deska. Motion carried with 5 yea votes.

Trustee Cohoe made a **motion** to pay the List of Bills in the amount of \$27249.63 and the Additions to the List of Bills in the amount of \$25469.24, and Payroll in the amount of \$19689.69, seconded by Trustee Deska. Motion carried with 5 yea votes.

Treasurer John Righi presented the Treasurers Report which was received and filed.

The Zoning Report was received and filed.

Ted Orm from the Montmorency Road Commission presented a report on the happenings within the Road Commission. Mr. Orm stated that they have been doing some cold patching, that most of the sand and salt mixtures were completed for the townships. Mr. Orm stated that some guard rails were going to have to be elevated to a new height after some of the roads in the county were resurfaced, stating that the ones on 491 were still the correct height. Trustee Cohoe questioned about the problem of Jake brakes and how could something be done about the issue.

Under Other discussion was held on getting a new salt spreader for the maintenance department, new chairs for the Board room, and maybe a new table, these items are not in the budget for this year. It was discussed what an employee was paid for doing a certain job and if it should be stipend as it was 25 years ago.
